### **BIBLE STORY TIME**

This week we had so much fun learning about how Jesus' disciples went fishing together after His resurrection. They were not catching any fish, then a person on the shore told them to throw their net on the other side of the boat. The fishermen listened and this time it was filled with fish! They recognized it was their friend, Jesus. Peter was so excited he jumped into the water to go to Jesus. After that, Jesus invited all His friends to come and have breakfast with Him.

You can read the story of Jesus' resurrection with your child in Matthew 28:1-10; Mark 16:1-10; Luke 24: 1-10; John 20:1-18 in a children's Bible.
