SPECIAL WORDS:

Jesus (point up) is always with me. (point thumbs to self)

BIBLE STORY:

Jesus Is Going To Heaven Matthew 28:16-20 & Mark 16:15-20

BIBLE STORY TIME

We had a great time learning that Jesus is always with me. We heard the Bible story about Jesus going to heaven. Before He left, He told the disciples that He would always be with them.

You can read the story of Jesus going to heaven with your child in Matthew 28:16-20 or Mark 16:15-20 in a children's Bible.

PLAY TIME



Play a game with your child. Have them guess where you are. Say, "I am picking up bananas, cheese and lots of food when I go here. Where am I? (the grocery store) Yes. When we buy food at the grocery store, is Jesus with us? Yes! Jesus is always with me." Repeat this, pretending you are in bed, at the park, and any other place you go. Remind them that Jesus is with them at each of these places.

BIBLE VERSE TIME

"God [point up] so loved the world [hands over heart] that He gave [open palms up] His one and only son." [place one finger out in front of you] John 3:16a [open hands like book]
