BIBLE STORY:

Shepherds Tell the Good News

Luke 2:1-20; Matthew 1:18-25



BIBLE STORY TIME

Jesus was sent to earth because of God’s love for people. The first people to hear Jesus’ birth announcement were shepherds. The news that the Savior was born was so exciting and important that they couldn’t keep the news to themselves. They left the field where the angels’ announced Jesus’ birth and told everyone that Jesus was born. We can tell others that Jesus is born, too!

You can read this story with your child in Luke 2:1-20 & Matthew 1:18-25 in a children’s Bible.

BIBLE VERSE TIME

“I bring you good news” [Hold hands to side of mouth (like a megaphone) turn head left] “Of great joy” [Hold hands to side of mouth (like a megaphone) turn head right] “Jesus has been born. [Raise hands excitedly to V above the head] **Luke 2:10-11b** [Hold hands like a book]

DRIVE TIME



As you drive, remind your kid that just like the shepherds, we need to **tell everyone** [place hands on either side of mouth], “Jesus is born!” [cradle arms and rock back and forth.] When your kid sees different places where people are, like a grocery store, a library, a school, say, “Jesus is born!”
