<u>Out</u>

-Jesus keeping His scars was important for the belief of others. What does this communicate to us today and the importance of our scars?

-What does it look like to "show up, doubts and all," like Thomas did a week after missing Jesus' first appearance?

-Spend time praying as a group thanking God for the hope and peace we now have because of His life, death, and resurrection.
