### **In**

### **Out**

-Pastor Brad points out that we often make God's will a series of "which, what, or who's," but we should rather see it as "whichever, whatever, or whomever." What changes when we take on this perspective?

-This sermon series is directed towards how we answer questions being asked by our kids, grandkids, or other young people in our lives. But often, they learn by watching. What actions do you want to take in this area that would communicate your own trust, focus, and surrender to the kids in your life?

### **Prayer**
