# GodTime

15 MINUTE DAILY

## Monday

READ: Matthew 18:23-35

**REFLECT:** The servant in this passage was given grace but did not give the same to others when they needed it. We do the same when we accept God's grace but refuse to give it to others, including our children/grandchildren. We must remember that our understanding of God's grace is demonstrated when we show this same grace to others.

**RESPOND:** Are you refusing to show grace to someone? One of your children? Ask God to reveal your fears in not doing so. Ask someone else how you can extend God's grace.

## Tuesday

READ: Galatians 5:13

**REFLECT:** Some may think that freedom is found with no boundaries and no guardrails. This is not true, especially in regard to raising our children. Our children need to exercise freedom within boundaries. The same is true with the guardrails God has placed for us. He wants us to use our freedom to serve others and Him.

**RESPOND:** List the guardrails God has placed in your life. Ask Him to help you discern if you are staying within them and if you are using your freedom to serve others and Him.

## Wednesday

READ: Proverbs 19:20

**REFLECT:** Our kids will gain the most rewarding wisdom from failure and consequences. When grace informs our parenting, we focus on helping our kids understand their failure rather than focus on punishment. We want to discipline our children in the same way God disciplines us — with the goal of restoration, not retribution.

**RESPOND:** Praise God for His grace-centered parenting that always has our good in mind. Ask Him to help you show this same grace in your relationships.

## Thursday

READ: Luke 6:45

**REFLECT:** In parenting, it can be easy to look only at the actions of our children, rather than the heart. This verse says that the heart is the root of who we are. Grace encourages us to look beyond what we see with our eyes to the heart of the issue. This is true in all our relationships, not only those with our children.

**RESPOND:** Ask God to help you see the heart behind behaviors. How can you respond to the root rather than just the behavior? See if this changes your perspective of others.

## Friday

READ: Ephesians 3:20-21

**REFLECT:** The influence parents have over their children is fueled solely by God's power within us and continues for generations to come. This is not only true for our children but in all our relationships. God does amazing things when we allow Him to work within us!

**RESPOND:** Ask God to work within you so that He can accomplish feats that only He can. Ask Him to reveal where you need to surrender to Him so He can work in your life.
