Monday

READ: Joshua 24:15; Mark 10:45

REFLECT: Jesus demonstrates how to serve others by going to the cross. When we serve our children, we are not making them our masters; we are choosing to look out for their best interests. Serving our children means we provide for them and discipline, train and teach them to walk in godliness and love for others.

RESPOND: What is one way you've served well in your parenting? If you are not a parent, what is one thing your parent did well to serve you? Praise God for this grace in your life.

Tuesday

READ: 1 Timothy 5:8

REFLECT: Paul's point in this verse is that there is an understanding that we take care of our own. Even nonbelievers know and do this. So, we are worse than an unbeliever who knows better when we don't provide for our children. This provision is for more than just money. It also includes providing for them emotionally and spiritually.

RESPOND: Ask God to help you discern where you are not trusting His provision.

Wednesday

READ: Proverbs 3:11-12; Proverbs 23:13-14

REFLECT: We demonstrate sacrificial serving when we discipline our children. As God serves us by disciplining us, we serve our children when we discipline them. This discipline is not to get them back for making us angry, we do it for their good. As God's discipline is for our benefit, our discipline of our children is for their benefit. **RESPOND:** How has disciplining your children been hard for you? Spend time with God thanking Him for His strength when you've done so.

Thursday

READ: Proverbs 9:10; Proverbs 22:6

REFLECT: There are many parenting resources that try to explain how we should train our children in the way they should go. God's Word says we should start with the "fear of the Lord." This fear does not mean they should be scared of God. Instead, we should instruct them to honor, love, and respect Him with their entire lives.

RESPOND: Do your children fear God because they see you fear Him? Write down ways you can train your children to pursue God through your own personal example.

Friday

READ: Deuteronomy 6:1-9

REFLECT: God told Israel to impress His directions on their children by talking about the commandments and creating symbols that they could remember. God knew the best way their children would obey His commandments is through sight. The best way our children can be inspired to follow God's words is by seeing us live it out, not just teach it.

RESPOND: Spend time praying for your children/grandchildren by name. If you don't have children, ask God to put a child on your heart and spend time interceding for them.
