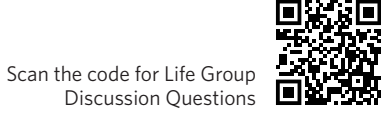

Monday

READ: Genesis 3:1-7

REFLECT: Ever since this passage, Satan has tempted humans to question God's trustworthiness by twisting His words. As a result, we doubt. However, our authentic doubt is not condemned by God. He invites us to come to Him with our questions, but He doesn't want us to stay there. He wants to transform our doubts into trust.

RESPOND: How often do you doubt and ask, "Did God really say ...?" Spend time with Him confessing your doubts and ask Him to help you increase your faith.

Tuesday

READ: John 18:28-38

REFLECT: Pilate was suspiciously wondering if, as a leader, anyone ever told him the truth. Though we don't live in Pilate's world, people's opinions about truth are not much different today. This gives us plenty of opportunities to share with others about Jesus.

RESPOND: How does modern society question truth? Do you find yourself believing in the lies that the enemy uses to try to deceive you?

Wednesday

READ: John 8:31-38

REFLECT: Jesus told the Jews that it was not their knowledge of "truth" that saved them. Instead, Jesus told them they would be set free by who they know — not what they know. God wants us to experience the freedom that only He can provide. Therefore, He invites us to wrestle with truth so that we may know the truth and be set free from lies.

RESPOND: Spend time thanking God for His truth, that he doesn't keep you in the dark about Him. Ask Him what He wants you to do in response to your freedom.

Thursday

READ: James 1:6-8

REFLECT: This passage is not saying it is wrong to be honest about our doubts. It is addressing having divided motives based on our feelings. God wants us to make progress in our faith journey amid our doubts. He does not want us to waver back and forth. Doubt is good but it should lead to growth.

RESPOND: How has doubt impacted your faith journey? How does James 1:6-8 speak to you?

Friday

READ: Proverbs 3:5-6

REFLECT: The words "trust" and "lean" are very close in meaning but with a nuance. Trusting means that we place ourselves completely at the mercy of another. Leaning is relying on something completely for support. When we trust in and lean on God, we are confessing that we will follow Him regardless of what we feel or see with our eyes.

RESPOND: In what areas of your life do you need to trust in and lean on God? Tell God about these areas and ask Him to help you increase your faith in Him.
