Monday

READ: Revelation 20:11-15

REFLECT: Of the approximately 130 million books published since the invention of the Gutenberg press, there is only one book (besides the Bible) that will matter in the end — the Book of Life. This book includes the names of those who have been redeemed by God's grace. Those not included are those who have rejected God's free offer of salvation.

RESPOND: Is your name in this Book of Life? Why or why not? If it isn't, make sure to talk with a pastor. If it is, ask God for discernment on how you can lead others to His grace.

Tuesday

READ: 2 Corinthians 5:10

REFLECT: Every Christian will have to give an account for his or her life. While we cannot obtain our salvation through our works, we will have to answer for what we've done with the salvation we've been given. God hasn't only given us salvation for our own sake; He has also given it to us for the sake of others.

RESPOND: How are you using the gift of your salvation? Ask God to reveal how you can grow in your salvation and use this growth to reach and minister to others.

Wednesday

READ: Hebrews 9:27-28

REFLECT: We often use the phrase "we are saved" to refer to the initial decision we made. It is true that we have been saved. However, this passage implies that salvation is not just in the past or present; it is also in the future. Rather than fearing God's judgment, we can look forward in hope knowing our salvation will be complete when He returns.

RESPOND: Praise God for not giving up on you. Thank Him for sticking with you and seeing your salvation through to the very end.

Thursday

READ: Romans 12:17-21

REFLECT: God is judge. But when we seek revenge (rather than justice) we are basically saying that our wisdom is better than God's. This passage encourages us to trust God to do what is right according to His wisdom. He will make things right one day. Trusting that He will do this can free us up to love others rather than seek revenge.

RESPOND: Think about situations in your own life where you want revenge. How are you trusting God to do what He deems right in the situation? What does trusting Him look like?

Friday

READ: Philippians 2:9-11

REFLECT: Jesus wants you to recognize His lordship today by daily surrendering to His will in your life. He wants to sit on the throne of your heart and steer every one of your thoughts and actions. He not only wants to be your Savior, but also your Lord!

RESPOND: Who is ruling your life? Ask God to reveal this to you. Make changes as necessary. Ask Him for power and grace to make these changes.

If designated to "Ukraine," 100% of your financial gift will be applied to needs such as transportation, school expenses, children's clothes, and medical needs.




