BIBLE TIME

Moses & the burning bush

Exodus 3-4

We had a great time learning about Moses and the burning bush! As Moses got closer to the bush, He saw that the bush did not burn up. God spoke through the bush and told Moses to go back to Egypt and tell Pharaoh to let the Israelite people leave. Moses was afraid and questioned why God would choose him to lead the Israelites, but God told Moses He would be with him and use signs to show Pharaoh. Then Moses obeyed and went back to Egypt and led the people out of Egypt to a new land!

You can read to your kid the story about Moses and the burning bush in the children's Bible in Exodus 3-4.
