## Monday

**READ:** Ephesians 4:17-32

**REFLECT:** Because God has saved us, he has also made us new. We are now someone completely different, yet we still live in the shadow of our past selves. Every day, we must choose who we are going to be.

**RESPOND:** How does your perspective shift when you view circumstances through your “new” self? What daily challenges hinder you from being who you truly are in Christ?

## Tuesday

**READ:** Romans 13:12-14; Ephesians 6:10-18

**REFLECT:** The next event in the timeline of church history is the return of Jesus. Only God knows exactly when this will occur. Until then, we are at war with our sin nature and the forces of evil. Therefore, we must “put on” Jesus by living out who we are in him. Each day we can choose to be who we are in Christ and refuse to be who we are not.

**RESPOND:** Have you settled into a casual life and forgotten that you are at war? If so, what can you do to reengage and “put on” the armor of God?

## Wednesday

**READ:** Colossians 3:5-10; 1 John 1:5-7

**REFLECT:** When we put on Jesus, we will put to death our old self. Our old self was associated with deeds of darkness, upon which God’s wrath will come. Why would we want to put ourselves in a place that is unsafe? Why not walk in the light of our new life in him and enjoy the blessings that result from doing so?

**RESPOND:** Ask God to give you the strength to walk in the light of your new life today. Write down several action steps you can take to ensure you will do so.

## Thursday

**READ:** Ezekiel 36:26

**REFLECT:** God promised the people of Israel he would renew them after a period of his discipline. Although their hearts had become hardened, he assured them he would transform their hearts. The heart symbolizes the whole person — one’s mind, will, and emotions. Likewise, when Jesus makes us a new person, he also gives us a new heart.

**RESPOND:** Has your heart become hardened due to sin or life circumstances? If so, give God permission to work in your heart and begin to create a new one.

## Friday

**READ:** 2 Corinthians 5:17-20

**REFLECT:** The new life we have in Christ should motivate us to see others experience this new life as well. In fact, God desires for us to be his agents of reconciliation. He wants us to bring others to him so he can do a work in their hearts much like he did in ours!

**RESPOND:** Ask God to open your eyes and your heart so you can see those who are open to God’s work in their lives. Ask him for strength and wisdom to discern how you can talk with them about God and even invite them to Pathway.
