Monday

READ: Ephesians 4:1-6

REFLECT: Unity is only possible when we walk in a manner worthy of our calling as children of God. This worthy manner of walking occurs when we are humble, gentle, and patient with one another. All of these qualities are found in Christ. When we are walking with him, we will naturally possess and demonstrate these qualities.

RESPOND: Is it possible for unity to exist when we are prideful and impatient? How are you ensuring unity in your relationships through your own walk with God?

Tuesday

READ: Ephesians 4:7-13; 1 Corinthians 12:1-11

REFLECT: Any gift we have is from God. Therefore, the presence of pride in our lives means that we have forgotten the source of our gifts. When we remember that our gifts are given to us by God, we can truly possess humility, gentleness, and patience with others that will lead to unity.

RESPOND: What are the gifts God has given you? How are you using them? Look for ways this week to use them to serve God and others.

Wednesday

READ: Ephesians 4:14-16

REFLECT: When we pursue Christ we will grow in our knowledge about him and we will grow relationally. We will know how to love others as Christ loves them. To possess knowledge about God without love for others leads us to legalism. If we possess love but it is not God's kind of love, then our love will always come up short.

RESPOND: How are you growing in knowledge about God and in your relationships with others? How is this growth leading to unity in your relationships and in the church?

Thursday

READ: 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

REFLECT: While possible, taking the Lord's Supper alone does not allow us to experience what God intends us to experience. Only when we are with others during the Lord's Supper are we truly able to experience the full measure of what it means. It represents the unity we are to have with both Christ and others!

RESPOND: Is there disunity between you and someone else? What steps can you take to repair any disruption between you and them?

Friday

READ: John 17:20-23

REFLECT: Jesus' last lengthy prayer focused on the need for the church to be unified. The end purpose of this unity is so that the unbelieving world may believe in Jesus as we do. Therefore, Jesus' last prayer should be our first priority!

RESPOND: What would your unbelieving friends say about your relationships with other Christians? How do your relationships with other believers testify the gospel?
