TODAY: APRIL 19-20

Bible Story: Jesus' Resurrection *Matthew 27:57-66; 28:1-10*

Big Idea: Jesus loves us.

Focus: Jesus rose from the dead

Memory Verse: "God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son. Anyone who believes in Him will not die but will have eternal life." *John 3:16 NIV*

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Matthew 27:57-66; 28:1-10

Jesus's life displayed His love for everyone. The ultimate display of His love was when He chose to take our place and die for our sins on the cross. Jesus was placed in a guarded tomb, which was sealed with a giant stone. Three days later, women found the tomb miraculously empty! An angel told them Jesus had risen. Jesus appeared to the women in the garden, proving that He was alive!

He Question: How could Jesus rise from the dead?

God in His great power raised Jesus from the dead, proving that He was defeating death and sin forever.

We Question: What does it mean for us that Jesus is alive?

Because Jesus defeated death, we can be forgiven of our sins and we can have eternal life with God forever.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Every one of us has done wrong things. But God loves us so much that He sent His own son, Jesus, to live among us. Jesus willingly entered into death and separation from God. When God raised Jesus back to life, He defeated death and made a way for everyone who believes in Jesus to live forever with God. Pray that you would live each day in the hope that comes from knowing Jesus is alive
