Big Idea: Jesus loves us.

Focus: Jesus loves us and gives us grace

### **Bible Story Summary:**

### Read and meditate on John 21

After they heard about the empty tomb, Peter and some other disciples were fishing. They had no luck catching fish. Jesus called out from the shore and told them to place their nets on the opposite side. When they did, their nets were filled. One of the disciples realized it was Jesus speaking to them. Peter jumped in and swam to shore. Jesus cooked breakfast for them. He asked Peter if he loved Him. Peter replied, "Yes," and Jesus told Peter to feed His sheep. He repeated this twice more. Jesus had not only forgiven Peter for denying Him three times, but He was restoring Him to ministry.

### He Question: How does Jesus show us grace?

Because of our sin, we deserve to be separated from God forever. But Jesus shows us grace that when we have faith in Him, He rescues us from our sin. Jesus restores our relationship with God when we trust Him. Someday He will restore everything when He returns.

#### We Question: How can we respond to grace?

We can worship God for rescuing us through His grace and we can seek to grow closer to Him, honoring Him in all we do.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.





As a family, talk about God's grace and what it means that He gives us grace. Then think about some specific ways that you can show others the same kind of grace this week.

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that Jesus loves you.


## DAY 2

Thankfully God's grace isn't like baseball. He doesn't give us three strikes and say we're out. God loves us so much! God's grace allows us to be forgiven for ALL of our mistakes. ALL of our sins are wiped clean because of God's grace.

With the help of a parent, write the word "SIN" by 1st base, 2nd base, and 3rd base on the baseball diamond. Then across the entire baseball diamond, write the words "GOD'S GRACE". Know that "GOD's GRACE" forgives us of all of our sins.


# DAY 4
