Bible Story: Peter's Denial Matthew 26:36-75, Luke 22:54-62

Big Idea: Jesus loves us.

Focus: Jesus loves us no matter what.

Memory Verse: "God so loved the world that he gave his one and only

Son. Anyone who believes in him will not die but will have

eternal life." John 3:16 NIrV

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Matthew 26:36-75, Luke 22:54-62

In the Upper Room, as Jesus shared the Passover meal with His disciples, Jesus predicted that the disciples would turn away from him that very night. Peter insisted he never would, but Jesus said that before the rooster crows, Peter would deny him 3 times. Peter told Jesus he would never do that.

Then Jesus took his disciples to the Garden of Gethsemane to pray with Him. Jesus asked God to spare Him from suffering but submitted to God's will. He returned and found His disciples asleep. He urged them to pray. Judas then arrived with soldiers, and betrayed Jesus with a kiss. Jesus was arrested and taken to the high priest. Peter followed but denied knowing Jesus three times when questioned by bystanders. When the rooster crowed, Peter was reminded of Jesus' prediction that he would deny Him. Peter left and wept.

He Question: What is Jesus' love like?

Jesus loves unconditionally. He loved us before we loved Him, and nothing will separate us from that love. He also loves sacrificially, giving His own life to rescue us from sin.

We Question: Can our sin make Jesus stop loving us?

No. Even though we all sin, He will never stop loving us. We didn't do anything to make Jesus love us, and we can't do anything that will make Him stop.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Go around the table and have each person share one character trait they love about each other. When finished, talk about how God's love for everyone compares to your family's love for each other

READ Romans 8:38-39 (NIrV)
