Bible Story: Peter's Confession Matthew 16:13-23

Big Idea: Jesus knows us.

Focus: Jesus knows us and wants us to know Him.

Memory Verse: "Lord, you have seen what is in my heart. You know all about me."

(Psalm 139:1)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Matthew 16:13-23

Jesus asked His disciples who they believed He was. Peter replied, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Jesus praised Peter and said, "On this rock, I'll build my church." This meant Jesus was the promised Rescuer. He warned He'd suffer and die but rise again. Peter objected, not understanding Jesus' true mission: to save everyone from sin, not just become an earthly king. Jesus reassured the disciples that His suffering was part of God's plan for redemption.

He Question: What does it mean that Jesus is the Christ?

Christ means "Messiah" or "Anointed One." All through the Old Testament, God had promised to send a Rescuer to save the people from their sins. Jesus is that Rescuer—the Christ.

We Question: What does it mean to have a relationship with Jesus?

When we trust in Jesus as our Savior, we can have a friendship with Him. We can talk to Him through prayer and learn more about Him through the Bible. He is always with us, and we can live with Him forever.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does

this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly

READ Romans 10: 9-10 (NIrV)
