Bible Story: Jesus is Anointed *Luke 7:36-50*

Big Idea: Jesus knows us.

Focus: Jesus knows what we've done and loves us.

Memory Verse: "Lord, you have seen what is in my heart. You know all about me."
(Psalm 139:1)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Luke 7:36-50

Simon, a Pharisee, invited Jesus to eat in his home. A woman came in weeping and washed Jesus' feet with her tears and her hair. The Pharisee wondered why Jesus would allow the woman there since she was known as a sinner. Jesus told Simon a story of two men who owed different amounts of money and were both forgiven. The woman had been forgiven much, so she loved much.

Jesus knew the heart of the woman who anointed His feet with oil, and He loved her deeply despite her sin. Jesus knows us. He knows our sins and failures, yet He still loves us.

He Question: Does Jesus know what people do?

Jesus knows everything that everyone does, both good and bad. He loves us, even though He knows everything we have done. There is nothing we do to earn His love and nothing we can do that will make Him stop loving us.

We Question: What can we do when we mess up?

We can ask Jesus to forgive us for our sin. He forgives us and makes us new again. When we mess up, we can do our best to do better in the future and we can live a life of gratitude for His love and forgiveness.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Ask each other the following question. What is something that you have done wrong recently that you need to ask Jesus to forgive you? Take some time to talk about the things that each of you have done wrong. Pray together and ask Jesus to forgive you.



DAY 1

READ "Lord, you have seen what is in my heart. You know all about me." *Psalm 139:1 (NirV)*

This is the memory verse for the month of February! All month long we are learning that Jesus knows and loves us.

How many times do you put on clothes in a day? Think about it, you put on clothes to go to school, snow gear to play outside, maybe a uniform for a sports practice, and then pajamas before bed!

Every time you put on an item of clothing today, say the memory verse! This is a great way to remember that Jesus knows you.

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that Jesus knows you.

DAY 2

READ "Blessed is a person whose lawless acts are forgiven. Their sins have been taken away." *Psalm 32:1 (NirV)*

With the help of a parent, find a pebble, marble, or small rock. Put it in one of your shoes and put the shoe on your foot.

Now try to do some jumping jacks, walk around your house, or run in place.

Was it easy or difficult to do those activities with something in your shoe?

It probably hurt quite a lot!

You were probably so grateful when the rock or pebble was removed. Sin is like that, too. When you pray to Jesus and ask for forgiveness for your sins, your sins are removed!

DAY 3

READ Luke 7:36-50 (NirV)

Luke 7:36-50 is our Bible story for this week. In the Bible story, we learned about a woman and Simon and what happened when Jesus was invited over for dinner.

There are several actions, listed below, that were done by Simon or the woman. Read each action and draw a line to the correct person from our Bible story who completed the action.

The woman **Simon**

- Invited Jesus over for dinner.**
- Poured perfume on Jesus' feet.**
- Lived a sinful life.**
- Had their sins forgiven.**

No matter what others said or did, Jesus saw this woman as forgiven! The woman needed forgiveness—and so do we. Take a minute and talk to God. Make sure to thank Him for forgiving you.
