**Bible Story:** Peter & John Before the Sanhedrin *Acts 4:1-22 (Supporting: Acts 3)*

**Big Idea:** You can have confidence knowing that Jesus is always with you.

**Memory Verse:** “Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.” *Philippians 1:6, NIV*

**Life App:** Confidence—Living like you believe what God says is true.

**Bible Story Summary:** In **Acts 4:1-22** we see that Peter and John didn’t care that they were arrested for talking to others about Jesus. They had so much confidence in Jesus, that they would keep talking about Jesus even if it meant dying for their faith.

**You can have confidence knowing that Jesus is always with you.** When Jesus is with you, you can face anything. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, we don’t have to fear anything that happens. God can give us the confidence to trust Him no matter what.

## DAY 1

*Read Acts 4:1-4*

Peter and John were confident in God, that is for sure. They continued to tell people about Jesus even when they were put in jail for it. There was only one way Peter and John could have stood up to the religious leaders the way they did; they had been with Jesus. That should give us confidence! After all, Peter and John weren’t superheroes. The Bible says they were “ordinary men with no training.” For them, it was simple. They knew Jesus was with them.

**Jesus is with us, too. We can know that for a fact! The next time you feel afraid, remember Jesus is with you. Now that should help you each day, no matter what’s ahead!**

## DAY 2

*Read Philippians 4:13*

**Fill in the first part of this verse.**

Aren’t you glad it doesn’t say, “For I can do somethings” or “For I can do most things”? This verse reminds you that you can do **EVERYTHING!** How? Find out by filling in the rest of the sentence.

You don’t have to figure out how to be strong enough to go through hard things. Jesus will give you the strength you need if you just ask Him. And that is a promise!

**ASK** Jesus to make you strong with His help.



# DAY 3

Read 1 Corinthians 10:13

Have you ever felt like doing something, but you know it is wrong? Maybe you felt like watching something you know your parents told you not to watch. Maybe you felt like taking a toy from your brother or sister when they are playing with it. That is temptation. This verse reminds us that we will be tempted, or "want" to do something wrong, but Jesus can help us not do it. He can make us strong.

Walk around your house and count all the ways out of your house. How many doors, windows, doggie doors, or garage doors do you have? \_\_\_\_\_

Even if you only have one or two, that's really all you need, right? And the great news, when it comes to temptation, God has promised to give us a way out. So, if there is something you know you shouldn't be doing, or if you have a friend who is always asking you to do something you know isn't good, God has promised a way out for you. Jesus is with you always!

**THANK** Jesus for giving you a way out from doing wrong things.

# DAY 4

Read Isaiah 41:10

Finish the first part of this verse and remember, this is what God says to you.

"Don't be afraid, for \_\_\_ am with \_\_\_."

Take a dry erase marker into the bathroom and look in the mirror. As you look at yourself, think about the things that you are facing right now that are hard or something that scares you. Now make a worried face in the mirror.

Ask your parent if you can write "I am with you!" on the mirror, above where your face. Then, look in the mirror again and strike a confident pose. Whatever it is that you're facing right now, you can face it without fear because you know that Jesus is with you!
