## PARENT CORNER TODAY: MARCH 1-2 weekly

Bible Story: Jesus Heals the Blind Mark 10:46-52

Big Idea: Jesus cares about us.

Focus: Jesus cares about us and hears us.

Memory Verse: "Turn all your worries over to Him. He cares about you."

(1 Peter 5:7)

#### **Bible Story Summary:**

Read and meditate on Mark 10:46-52

Time and time again, Jesus showed that He cared for everyone, regardless of their social standing. He paid special attention to the poor and the marginalized. Jesus spent His time with the outcasts of society and chose to be the ultimate sacrifice for evervone.

This week we are going to see a time when Jesus and His disciples were near Jericho. There was a blind beggar named Bartimaeus there. Bartimaeus heard Jesus passing by and called out for mercy, recognizing Him as the Messiah. Despite being told to be quiet, Bartimaeus persisted. Jesus stopped and asked what Bartimaeus wanted. Bartimaeus replied he wanted to see. Jesus commended the man's faith and restored his sight. Bartimaeus followed Jesus, praising God.

#### He Question: What can we ask Jesus?

Jesus cares about us and our struggles, and we can call out to Him about anything at any time.

#### We Question: Does Jesus always answer us?

Jesus always hears and always answers, but that doesn't mean He always does what we ask. His answer may be "no" or "not yet."

#### Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



As you're driving somewhere, have your child close their eyes and see if they can guess where they are. Being blind was difficult for Bartimeaus. What is something that is difficult for you? No matter how difficult life can seem, know that Jesus cares about us and hears us when we pray.

Our story from the Bible this week is about a man, Bartimaeus, who was born blind. He had to learn to do many things without being able to see. Can you imagine not being able to ever see? In the story, Bartimeaus continued to pray to God and asked God to allow him to see. Bartimaeus knew that Jesus cared about him and heard his prayers. He kept praying until one day Jesus finally answered his prayers and gave him the ability to see.
