Bible Story: Life Changes (Zacchaeus) *Luke 19:1-10*

Big Idea: When you forgive others, it can change them.

Memory Verse: "Put up with one another. Forgive one another if you are holding something against someone. Forgive, just as the Lord forgave you "

Colossians 3:13 (NirV)

Life App: Forgiveness – deciding that someone who has wronged you doesn't have to pay.

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Luke 19:1-20.

Jesus often interacted with the most unexpected people. Zacchaeus was a tax collector working for Rome. He earned a reputation for taking advantage of his fellow Jewish people. Zacchaeus was considered an outcast by many, so he must have been shocked when Jesus asked to come over to his home for a meal. When Zacchaeus encountered Jesus, he changed. He went back to the people he had cheated and returned four times as much money as he took from them.

When you forgive others, it can change them. When God forgives us, it changes us from the inside out. The same can be true when you forgive others. You never know what can happen when you take the first step toward forgiveness. When you decide to reach out and offer forgiveness, it can change the way the other person sees you, the situation, and the impact of their actions.

Meal Time



While at a meal, ask everyone to make the face you describe. For example, "Show me your surprised face!" Or "Show me your sad face!" Have everyone participate in making the faces and do a few more rounds, using different words. Then, make the final round be, "Show me your face when someone forgives you!" Discuss how forgiveness can change how a person is feeling and why it is so important to forgive others.

DAY 1

READ *Luke 19:1-10*

Jesus chose to love and forgive Zacchaeus. And because of Jesus' forgiveness, Zacchaeus recognized his sin and changed his ways. The same can happen when we are forgiven and when we choose to forgive others. Everyone needs forgiveness, and when we forgive others, it can change them.

LOOK for opportunities to ask for forgiveness and forgive others.

DAY 2

READ *"Blessed are those who show mercy. They will be shown mercy." Matthew 5:7*

What is mercy? Circle the answer below.

- a. Forgiveness and kindness
- b. Choosing to treat someone with compassion.
- c. Letting someone off the hook.

Did you circle all the answers? When someone hurts you and asks for forgiveness, you have a choice. You can choose to show mercy and forgive, or you can hold onto your anger.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus told us that people who show mercy will be blessed. When we choose to forgive, to show mercy, we become more like Jesus.

Stop and thank God for forgiving you, no matter what. Ask God to help you to show mercy and compassion to the people around you.

READ "Now you should forgive him and comfort him. Then he won't be sad more than he can stand." 2 Corinthians 2:7
