# PARENT CORNER TODAY: MARCH 19 Weekly

Bible Story: Homecoming (The Story of the Lost Son) Luke 15:11-32

Big Idea: God will always forgive you.

Memory Verse: Put up with one another. Forgive one another if you are holding something against someone. Forgive, just as the Lord forgave you.

Colossians 3:13 (NIrV)

Life App: Forgiveness – deciding that someone who has wronged you doesn't have

to pay.

#### **Bible Story Summary:**

Read and meditate on Luke 15:11-32.

In Luke 15:11-32 Jesus shared a parable to help people understand God's amazing grace and forgiveness. A son came to his father and asked for his share of the inheritance. This broke the father's heart, but he went ahead and gave the son what he wanted. The son wasted all of the money and hit rock bottom. That's when he decided to go home to his father and ask for forgiveness. The father welcomed him home with open arms and threw a giant party for him. His older brother, on the other hand, chose not to forgive and became angry with his brother. He not only missed out on a party, but he also missed out on rebuilding a relationship with his brother.

God will always forgive you. Jesus' parable is such an amazing reminder of God's love. God's grace and forgiveness is so deep and wide. When we come to God and ask for forgiveness, God is there waiting with open arms, offering unfailing love that restores the relationship we've broken. This is all possible because of Jesus. We pray that every kid understands what Jesus did for them and trusts God with their whole life.



Read Luke 15:1-7 as a family. Each think about something that you would be really upset about if you lost or misplaced and think about how long you would search for that item. In the Bible, God tells us that whenever, we get lost or need forgiveness. He will always come search for us . . . for a long as it takes. We are His prized possession that He wouldn't want to lose. As a family, thank God for always searching for you and finding you when you're lost.





### DAY 1

**READ** "But God loves us deeply. He is full of mercy. So he gave us new life because of what Christ has done. He gave us life even when we were dead in sin. God's grace has saved you." Ephesians 2:4-5

With a parent grab a piece if tin foil from the kitchen. See how shiny it is? Next, crumple it up into a ball. Now, try and make it look like it did before. Can you do it?

This is similar to how our lives look when we mess up. We can try to make it right on our own but no matter how hard we try, we will never be like the shiny tin foil again.

But there is good news! God loves you! God knew that our sins and mess ups would separate us from Him, so God sent Jesus to die in the cross for our sin to that we could be forgiven.

# DAY 2

READ "God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in him will not die but will have eternal life." John 3:16

God loved. God gave. We believe. We receive.

Those are the four big ideas in today's verse. God loved us (all of us) so much He gave us Jesus. When we believe in Jesus (ask Him to be our Savior), we'll receive eternal life (life forever in heaven).

Draw a big red heart. Inside the heart, write, "God loves me!" Hang this up somewhere in your house to remind you and your family about God's love.

SEEK to understand more about how much God loves you!

# DAY 3

**READ** "Lord, you are forgiving and good. You are full of love for all who call out to you." Psalm 86:5

Following God doesn't make you perfect. You'll still mess up and need to ask God and others for forgiveness. Today's verse reminds us that God is forgiving and that He loves us, even when we mess up!

Ask a parent to help you make up a song for this verse to help you memorize it. Sing it over and over again until you can do it by yourself. Then, teach it to someone else in your house!
