Bible Story: Jesus welcomes all Luke 18:15-17: 19:1-10

Big Idea: Jesus cares about us.

Focus: Jesus cares about everyone

Memory Verse: "Turn all your worries over to Him. He cares about you."

(1 Peter 5:7)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Luke 18:15-17; 19:1-10

Jesus was traveling when crowds gathered to hear Him. The disciples tried to stop children from reaching Jesus. Jesus rebuked the disciples, welcomed the children and blessed them. Later He encountered Zacchaeus, a despised tax collector who climbed a tree to see Him. Jesus invited Himself to Zacchaeus' home. Zacchaeus listened to Jesus and believed in Him. He pledged to give to the poor and repay those he wronged. Jesus welcomes everyone.

He Question: Why does Jesus care about people?

Jesus is love and loves all people deeply. People are created by God and every person is made in His image.

We Question: Who is important to Jesus?

Every single person, no matter their age, status, or background, is precious to Jesus. He loves and welcomes everyone.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly



Before leaving for work and school, think about one person that you can show love to and care for today. Draw a heart on your hand. Whenever you look at it today, think about how you can care about that person.





DAY 1

READ "Turn all your worries over to Him. He cares about you." 1 Peter 5:7 (NIrV)
