Bible Story: The last supper Matthew 26:1-5, 20-35

Big Idea: Jesus cares about us.

Focus: Jesus cares about us and chose to be our sacrifice

Memory Verse: "Turn all your worries over to Him. He cares about you."

(1 Peter 5:7)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Matthew 26:1-5, 20-35

All month we have been learning that Jesus cares about us. This week we will see the extent of His love for us when He chose to die on the cross for our sins. As we draw closer to Easter, we will look at the last few days of Jesus' life.

In Matthew 26, the religious leaders schemed against Jesus, plotting to get rid of Him. During the Passover meal, Jesus revealed that one of His disciples would betray Him. It was Judas. Jesus talked about His coming sacrifice using bread and wine, symbolizing His body and blood. Jesus shared with His disciples that it was His body and His blood that would be the final sacrifice that would make the forgiveness of sin available to everyone.

He Question: How is Jesus our sacrifice?

Jesus never sinned, but He chose to take the punishment for our sin in our place. Because of His great love for us, He died in our place so that we could be forgiven.

We Question: Why did we need a sacrifice?

We all sin. Sin is so bad the only true punishment for it is death. We deserve to die for our sins. To be rescued, we needed someone to die in our place to take the punishment we deserved.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.





Jesus cares about us so much that He chose to be our sacrifice on the cross so that we could be forgiven of our sins. Sacrificing something is hard! Go around the table and have each person think of one sacrifice they can make to serve as a reminder of the sacrifice Jesus made for us.

READ "We have been made holy by what God wanted. We have been made holy because Jesus offered his body once and for all time." Hebrews 10:10

Find a piece of paper and a marker or crayon. Draw a big heart on the paper. Write down (or draw a picture) of a way you have sinned. When you are finished, take a moment to pray to Jesus and ask Him to forgive you of your sin.

"Dear Jesus, thank You for loving us so much that You chose to sacrifice Yourself on the cross for our sins. I am sorry that I Please forgive me for what I did so my heart can be wiped clean. In Your name I pray. Amen."

Now take that paper and crumble it up. Toss it in the trash can and know that you are forgiven because of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross.
