TODAY: MARCH 30-31

Bible Story: Alive (Easter) *Luke 24:1-12, 36-49*

Big Idea: Jesus is alive.

Memory Verse: “God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son. Anyone who believes in him will not die but will have eternal life.” *John 3:16 (NIRV)*

Life App: Easter – Celebrating that Jesus is alive.

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Luke 24:1-12, 36-49.

Today we are celebrating Jesus’ resurrection as described in Luke 24:1-12, 36-49. God went to great lengths to make peace with us. All of God’s promises came true, and everything that Jesus said and did led up to this moment. When Jesus paid the price for our sin on the cross and then came back to life, He made it possible for us to have peace with God forever! THAT is something to celebrate!

Jesus is alive. As we celebrate Easter this year, we want kids to know why we make such a big deal about this special day. Jesus isn’t just some person that said and did some cool things a long time ago. Jesus IS God’s Son . . . and through Him, we can have life forever with God. That’s only possible because Jesus is alive! We pray that kids will understand what Jesus has done for them and choose to put their trust in Him.

Before going to bed, take the Easter box you made out. On the outside, you should have the stickers, “A”, “B”, and “C.” Do you remember what each letter stands for?

As a family, review the ABC’s. A is for Admit you have sinned. Tell God you have sinned and you are sorry for those sins. B is for Believe in Jesus. Trust Him to forgive you. C is Choose to grow up God’s way. Read the Bible and obey it. Let Him lead your life.

Discuss together what it means to grow up God’s way and to keep following Him.

DAY 1

READ “God was pleased to bring all things back to himself. That’s because of what Christ has done. These things include everything on earth and in heaven. God made peace through Christ’s blood, by his death on the cross.” *Colossians 1:20*

There are a lot of fun things that come with the Easter season. Candy, egg hunts, and springtime! But none of those things are the reason we celebrate. Jesus came to make things right between us and God. DAY 2

READ “I leave my peace with you. I give my peace to you. I do not give it to you as the world does. Do not let your hearts be troubled. And do not be afraid.” *John 14:27*

Have you ever thought a situation was going to go one way, but it ended up being way different than you thought? Maybe you thought a movie was going to end a certain way and it surprised you, or maybe you weren’t friends with someone at first, but then you were surprised by all you had in common. We have all had things happen that we don’t expect, but many did not expect what Jesus would do.

When Jesus came to Earth, many hoped that He would be a leader who would rule and bring peace. And Jesus did come to bring peace, but not in the way that they expected. Jesus came to bring peace to our hearts!

God sent Jesus to pay the price for our sin. That’s the peace that Jesus brings. When we put our trust in Jesus and what He has done for us, we can have peace!

REMEMBER that Jesus came to bring peace.
