PARENT CORNER weekly

TODAY: MAY 3-4

Bible Story: The Great Commission Acts 1:6-11, Matthew 28

Big Idea: The Holy Spirit is our Helper.

Focus: The Holy Spirit is our Helper, and He gives us power.

Memory Verse: "But the Father will send the Friend in my name to help you. The Friend is the Holy Spirit. He will teach you all things." John 14:26a (NIrV)

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Acts 1:6-11, Matthew 28

After Jesus died on the cross, He appeared to the disciples to show them He was alive again! He stayed with them for forty days and told them about the kingdom of God. Jesus gave them a mission to tell everyone about Him and make disciples and told them they would receive the Holy Spirit. After Jesus said these things, He was taken up to heaven on a cloud.

When Jesus left this world, He did not leave us alone. He sent the Holy Spirit to be our Helper. Just like the Holy Spirit empowered the disciples to share about His goodness to the world, He helps us and leads us today. The Holy Spirit is still our Helper.

He Question: Who is the Holv Spirit?

The Holy Spirit is God and has all of the power and authority of God. He is the Helper Jesus promised.

We Question: How does the Holy Spirit help us?

When we trust in Jesus as Savior, the Holy Spirit helps us follow God, remember His Word, and spread His Gospel throughout the world.

Me Question: What does God want me to know about Him, and what does this mean for my life?

Kids will be given the opportunity to reflect on the truth they learned about God and respond accordingly.



Before bed, talk with your kid about both of your days. Did anyone help you or them today? Maybe a teacher helped them figure out a math problem or a friend helped them carry their things when their hands were full. Maybe a coworker helped you learn something new. Discuss how the Holy Spirit helps you grow up God's way.



DAY **1**

READ "But the Father will send the Friend in my name to help vou. The Friend is the Holv Spirit." John 14:26a (NIrV)

John 14:26a is our memory verse for the month of May. It teaches us that God sent the Holy Spirit to be our helper. The Holy Spirit is God and has all the power and authority of God. He is the Helper whom Jesus promised!

Today, you're going to play a fun game to help you memorize the memory verse. With the help of a parent, find a way to play some music. It could be a radio, a phone, Alexa, or something else. Have your parent start the music. As the music plays, dance around! Have some fun! Have your parent stop the music at some point. When the music stops, freeze and say the memory verse. Do this five or six times to help you memorize this month's memory verse.

PRACTICE this memory verse as a reminder that the Holy Spirit is our Helper

READ John 14:16-17 (NIrV)

With the help of a parent, grab a flashlight and head into a room that can be made dark. Turn off the lights and see if you can see anything.

Now, turn on the flashlight. Were you able to see very much? Do you think you could get dressed or move around without bumping into anything?

Without light, our eyes cannot see in the dark. The light from the flashlight allows you to see around the room. Now you know which way to walk and where everything is.

The flashlight is like the Holy Spirit. It helps us when we need help. The Holy Spirit helps give us power to spread God's word to others. Keep the flashlight somewhere you can see it this week as a reminder that the Holy Spirit will help you and give you power.
