TODAY: NOVEMBER 20

**Bible Story:** Safe and Sound (Daniel Is Thrown into a Den of Lions) *Daniel 6*

**Big Idea:** You can have courage because God is with you.

**Memory Verse:** "Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

*Joshua 1:9b (NIV)*

**Life App:** Courage—Being brave enough to do what God wants you to do, even when you're afraid

### Bible Story Summary:

**Read and meditate on Daniel 6.**

In Daniel 6, God's people, the Israelites, were in captivity. Even in a foreign land that didn't worship God, Daniel was known for faithfully praying to God. And when the leaders tried to

trap him and have him killed, Daniel had courage and continued to honor God in spite of what could happen to him. Unfortunately, Daniel was caught and thrown into the lions' den . . . but God was with Daniel and protected him by shutting the lions' mouths.

We can have courage because God is with us. Sometimes a kid might feel like they're the only one of their friends who's choosing to do what's right. Moments like these can take a huge amount of courage. As kids learn how Daniel trusted God and found courage to do the right thing, they'll remember that God is always with them too. God can give them the strength and courage they need to keep making the wise choice.



As your kid is eating breakfast, ask them about their plans for the day and what they want to do. Discuss if there is anything they are worried or excited about. Pray with your kid asking God to help you remember that He has a plan we can trust, so we do not have to worry about what will happen.

# DAY 1

**READ Proverbs 16:20**

# DAY 2

**READ Proverbs 16:3**

Have you ever followed a plan? Sometimes we make plans that don't work out. Maybe you wake up to find it raining on the day you'd planned to go to the park. Maybe you planned to visit your grandmother but she's sick. Maybe you wanted to spend the afternoon reading a new book but your parents need your help in the yard.

Even when our plans change, God is still in control. The next time you make a plan, stop and ask God for wisdom. Ask God to help you follow Him, then trust Him no matter what happens.

**THANK** God for being worthy of trust.

# DAY 3

**READ** Proverbs 19:21

When it comes to trust, we need to remember that God has a plan. Ultimately, God wants everyone to know Him. We can all have a relationship with God because of Jesus. We can ask for guidance and for God's plan for our lives.

Do you have a plan for today? What would you like to do? Tell God about your plans for the day and ask for help to make choices that honor God all day long.

**ASK** God to show you what plans are right for you.
