Bible Story: Israel Goes through the Red Sea Exodus 13:17

Big Idea: God is faithful.

Focus: God is faithful and in control.

Memory Verse: "The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning."

Lamentations 3:22-23, NLT

Bible Story Summary:

Read and meditate on Exodus 13:17-14:31.

Faithful is a word that the Bible often uses to tell us who God is. That is why our Big Idea this month is **GOD IS FAITHFUL.** Faithful means trustworthy. God has been faithful throughout history and has helped people get through and overcome incredible difficulties.

In Exodus 13:17-14:31, God's people were on their way out of Egypt when Moses and the Hebrew people found themselves trapped between the Red Sea and Pharaoh's army in pursuit. But God had complete control of the situation, parting the Red Sea and saving His people.

God is faithful and in control. God is with us and is sovereign over every situation we face. We can have peace knowing that our faithful God is in complete control.

He Question: Is God faithful?

God is ALWAYS faithful. Deut. 7:9 says He is "The faithful God". At least 36 times in the Bible, God called faithful.

We Question: Can we really trust God no matter what?

God's faithfulness means He is true to His Word and dependable. We really can trust God no matter what.

Me Question: What does this mean for my life?

Whatever situation we face in life we have no need to fear. God is sovereign and in control.

DAY 1

READ "The Lord himself will go ahead of you. He will be with you. He will never leave you. He'll never desert you. So don't be afraid. Don't lose hope." Deuteronomy 31:8

This verse tells us that God is always with us, so we don't have to be afraid when we don't know what will happen next or everything feels out of control. We can have peace when something feels out of control because we know that God has a plan and is in control of everything! No matter what is happening, you can always pray and talk to God about it.

With the help of a parent, find a piece of paper and write down or draw a picture of something that happened today or this week that felt out of control?

Take some time to pray about what you wrote or drew on the paper as you remember that God is always in control.

DAY 2

READ "Let us not become tired of doing good. At the right time we will gather a crop if we don't give up." Galatians 6:9 (NIrV)

Grab a friend or family member and play a game of Trust Fall! Stand with your back facing your partner. When your partner is ready, lean back without looking and trust that your partner will catch you! Play a few rounds

That game was so much fun, but you had to trust that your partner would catch you.

Your partner was faithful. A person who is faithful is someone who does what they say they will do. This verse tells us that God is faithful. If God makes a promise...God keeps that promise. That means you can put all your trust in God! God loves you and will help you keep doing the right thing even when everything around you seems to be out of control.

DAY 3

READ "The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease.'

Lamentations 3:22 (NLT)

This is the memory verse for the month of October! This month we are learning about how God is always faithful. We are learning how God has always been faithful, and He will continue to always be faithful.

To practice the memory verse this week, create note cards with one word of the verse on each card. Then, with your parents, create a crooked path to walk on around your house. As you walk on the crooked path, say each word of the verse to practice memorizing your memory verse.
