Monday

READ: John 20:30-31

REFLECT: John recounted Jesus’ life and ministry so his original audience would have “life in his name.” The life that John refers to is both abundant life in the present and eternal life in the future. This also applies to us today. Unfortunately, we are tempted to “find life” in other things and people instead of Jesus.

RESPOND: How do those around you try to have a full life? How are you tempted to find life in anything other than Jesus? Write down these ways so you can be aware of them.

Tuesday

READ: John 3:16-17

REFLECT: Jesus often spoke of the life he came to give. On one occasion, he was talking to Nicodemus, a well-respected religious leader, about God’s promised Messiah. The idea that eternal life was given through the work of the Son rather than obedience to the Law would have been revolutionary to Nicodemus.

RESPOND: Have you received the gift of eternal life that Jesus came to give? If not, talk to a strong Christian about it. If so, how are you telling others about this eternal life?

Wednesday

READ: Romans 12:2; 1 Corinthians 2:14-16

REFLECT: Experiencing life in Christ means we will have his mind. Our minds are limited and are bent toward pleasing our own desires. Christ’s mind is unlimited, God-pleasing, and knows the thoughts of God. When we have the mind of Christ we will be able to discern how to wisely apply God’s Word to our lives.

RESPOND: What do you fill your mind with? How are you allowing God to transform your mind?

Thursday

READ: Romans 6:4; 2 Corinthians 5:17

REFLECT: Jesus’ resurrection results in a spiritual reality we can experience in the present. As Jesus was resurrected to a new life, we also can spiritually receive new life. Because of his resurrection, our sins can be forgiven and our old way of doing life can be replaced by the new life of Jesus in us.

RESPOND: What are several benefits Jesus’ resurrection has for your life in the present? What new perspectives and mentalities does it provide for you?

Friday

READ: 1 John 5:11; Revelation 21:3-4

REFLECT: The resurrection of Jesus provides a future for all believers. Because of his resurrection, our physical death is not the end of our story. The new, abundant life we are promised in the present is a foretaste of the eternal life we will experience in the future!

RESPOND: How does this future reality affect you in the present? Ask God to help you see how his life (especially the benefits of his resurrection) is relevant for your life today.
