Monday

READ: John 8:31-32; John 14:6

REFLECT: In this passage, Jesus speaks to the Jews who believed He was the Messiah. He invited them to know Him and to discover the freedom that is not possible without this relationship. As we become more strongly connected to Him, we, too, will discover freedom that would be impossible to experience otherwise.

RESPOND: Are you becoming closer to Jesus? How are you being set free to be who He desires you to be?

Tuesday

READ: John 15:1-8

REFLECT: Jesus tells us to abide in Him so we can bear good fruit. Our souls must be cared for and nurtured so we're ready to receive truth and live it out in a way that produces fruit. This is how His truth works in our lives. It transforms our character, deepens our love for others, and leads us to a fruitful life.

RESPOND: Compare your life now to what it was five years ago. Have you grown spiritually and are you producing more fruit? How? If not, why?

Wednesday

READ: Galatians 5:19-26

REFLECT: Before we became followers of Jesus and anchored in Jesus, we found security in works of the flesh. After all, our sin nature makes whatever is enticing to our flesh tempting and familiar. However, when we became new creations, God gave us the Holy Spirit to produce lasting spiritual fruit that benefits others, not only us.

RESPOND: Read over each part of the fruit of the Spirit. Which one are you lacking at the moment? Ask God for help in this area and be willing to respond however He asks.

Thursday

READ: 2 Timothy 3:16-17

REFLECT: Not only is Scripture inspired by God, but it is also relevant to our everyday lives. It is useful in teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training us to know His truth and be equipped for God's use. God's Word is useful so that we can become useful!

RESPOND: How has God's Word (His truth) been useful to you so far this week? Write down several ways and spend time thanking God for His Word's relevance in your life.

Friday

READ: Luke 10:25-37; James 1:22-25

REFLECT: The Samaritan in this story probably knew less about God's Word than the Jewish religious leaders did. But it was the Samaritan who did the right thing by stopping to help the victim. It's not enough to simply know God's word in our minds. We cannot be only hearers of the Word. We must be doers of the Word as well.

RESPOND: How is God's truth bearing fruit through you into the lives of others? Spend time asking God for His strength to help you bear fruit.
