A Story Told:



Monday

READ: John 4:1-42

REFLECT: In this story, Jesus crossed social and cultural barriers to reach a Samaritan woman with a checkered past. Her encounter with Jesus radically transformed her life and perspective of who she was. She had a new identity and purpose. Likewise, those who encounter Jesus have also been given a new identity and purpose.

RESPOND: In what area of your life do you need to hear more about your new identity in Christ? How will a full grasp of this identity change your perspective in this area?

Tuesday

READ: Mark 1:16-18; Luke 19:10

REFLECT: As an "up-and-coming rabbi," Jesus would have been sought by others. Instead, Jesus sought others first. He called on Simon and Andrew to do the same. In the same way, God sought us first and wants us to do the same to others!

RESPOND: Write down the names of two or three people with whom you can be more active in sharing your faith. Ask God to help you discern when and how you can do so.

Wednesday

READ: Philippians 3:20

REFLECT: We don't have to wait for heaven to live out our heavenly citizenship. Our identity as citizens of heaven can impact our perspective in the present. When we live out our heavenly citizenship on this earth, it will shape our priorities and perspectives, impact our conduct, character, and relationships, and guide our decision-making.

RESPOND: Write down ways a heavenly perspective can change the way you think and how you live. Ask God for wisdom and strength to apply these ways to your life.

Thursday

READ: 1 Peter 2:9-10: Hebrews 10:19-22

REFLECT: Old Testament priests stood in the gap between God and His people. As modern believers, we can function similarly by standing in the gap and interceding for others. We have direct access to His throne and can talk to God on behalf of others. Knowing this can transform our prayer lives and the way we view others.

RESPOND: Think of several ways this changes how you view others. Ask God to help you pray for certain people in your life and to see them as He sees them.

Friday

READ: 2 Corinthians 5:11-21

REFLECT: As ambassadors of God and His kingdom, we must remember that we represent God's name. Our identity as ambassadors means that we share the gospel message of reconciliation when given the opportunity. In short, because we have been reconciled to God, we can now help reconcile others to God.

RESPOND: Write down ways you can be a better ambassador for God. Ask God to show you how your identity can change your perspective on others and your circumstances.
