Monday

READ: Philippians 2:5-8

REFLECT: When we look at Jesus, we see someone who held a position of power but chose a different posture. Although He was in the place of ultimate authority, He chose humility and service. When we look at His influence and leadership, we can see the stark contrast. It was an intentional decision to serve others for a bigger cause.

RESPOND: How can you be intentional in using your influence to serve others rather than yourself? In short, how can you be more like Jesus at work and in your home?

Tuesday

READ: Mark 10:35-45

REFLECT: When we are not living a life surrendered to the Holy Spirit, our natural tendency is to strive for position and desire to be served, looked up to, respected, liked, loved, and honored. If we have influence, the temptation is to abuse, guard, or hoard it. But instead of looking at influence as a position, we need to look at it as a posture.

RESPOND: Why do you seek position at work or other places? Ask God to reveal your reasons and ask Him to align your motives and heart to that which glorifies Him.

Wednesday

READ: James 4:6-10

REFLECT: God's grace is given to those who are humble. He rejects and judges those who are proud. Satan pushes us toward pride and away from humility. God wants us to resist Satan so that we can draw near to Him and be exalted for His glory.

RESPOND: What are some ways you are tempted with pride? Ask God to help you overcome these temptations and give you a heart to resist Satan.

Thursday

READ: 2 Chronicles 7:13-15

REFLECT: The road to spiritual renewal in our nation is through God's church. If our nation is to experience God's presence, we as believers must humble ourselves before God. Humility invites God's presence and attention.

RESPOND: Ask God to show you ways in which you can humble yourself before Him. Be willing to listen to what He says and to do what He asks you to do.

Friday

READ: Matthew 23:2-12

REFLECT: The religious leaders of Jesus' time used their authority to demonstrate superiority over others. This superiority fed their desire to be praised and respected by the Jewish people. Jesus reserved His strongest words for religious leaders who pretended to be close to Him but were far from Him. They were not using their God-given authority in a God-honoring way.

RESPOND: Spend time asking God to help you use your influence at home and work in a way that glorifies Him.
