Monday

READ: John 13:34-35

REFLECT: The mark of true Christianity is unity. In this passage, Jesus gives a new command to His followers: Love one another as I have loved you. God's love should motivate us to love one another and teach us how we are to love one another. This model of God's love continues to leave an impact in the modern world.

RESPOND: How does God's desire for unity impact the way you treat other Christians in your life? Think of a Christian with whom you've disagreed recently. What are some ways you can still maintain unity even when you disagree?

Tuesday

READ: John 17:20-23

REFLECT: In the Garden of Gethsemane, right before His arrest, Jesus' primary concern is the unity of His children. As Jesus' identity and purpose come from the Father, He prays that our unity would be grounded and shaped by who we are in Him.

RESPOND: List ways that God and Jesus were one even on earth. Ask God how you can mirror His unity with Jesus in your own relationships with other believers.

Wednesday

READ: Philippians 2:1-5

REFLECT: In this passage, Paul calls us to be like-minded, have the same love, be one in spirit and mind, and value others above ourselves. This kind of unity does not come naturally. Our sin nature tempts us to look out for ourselves more than others. If we want to move toward God's unity, we must love intentionally and listen intently.

RESPOND: What is one thing you can do this week to promote unity in your church?

Thursday

READ: Ephesians 4:2-6

REFLECT: Many of us try to maintain unity with others but stop short. Paul encourages the Ephesian believers to "make every effort" to maintain this unity by seeking peace with all people. This may not always be possible, but we should do whatever we can. Jesus' prayer in John 17 is not for partial unity or the appearance of unity. It's for complete unity.

RESPOND: Write down some practical ways you can make every effort to maintain unity with other believers in your life.

Friday

READ: 1 Corinthians 12:27; Ephesians 4:15-16

REFLECT: Paul uses the image of a body to describe how Christians are connected with one another. With Christ as the head (chief ruler), the church is held together by each other, the support ligaments. The main nutrient of this body is love, as each ligament (believers) builds each other up and lives in unity with each other.

RESPOND: What other images come to mind when describing the unity of the church? How can these images motivate you toward unity with other believers?
