Monday

READ: Galatians 4:4-5; Isaiah 7:14

REFLECT: God is not one who is distant. He is near. This is why he did not send someone else to this earth. He chose to come himself to do something that no one else could do. He came to "touch" humanity by wrapping himself in flesh in order to redeem humanity.

RESPOND: Are there people you encounter that you are afraid to be near? Do you look the other way or go in the opposite direction if you see them approaching? What would Jesus' response be?

Tuesday

READ: 1 John 1:1-4

REFLECT: Can you imagine if you had personally seen and touched Jesus just like John? John must have been in awe of his experiences. To have witnessed and touched the Messiah would have been incomparable. While we have to wait until we can physically see and touch Jesus, there are many people who do not know him and who need his touch in their lives. God desires that we be his "touch" in their lives.

RESPOND: How are you being the "touch" and presence of Jesus to those who do not yet know him?

Wednesday

READ: Psalm 139:7-12

REFLECT: David found it mindboggling that God is everywhere at the same time. There was nowhere David could go without God's presence. This was an incredible comfort for David. It can be for us as well. Again, we see that God is an ever-present Father.

RESPOND: God desires to be near to you. Do you desire to be near to God? How has God revealed his "nearness" to you so far this week?

Thursday

READ: Luke 5:12-16

REFLECT: Jesus' words "I am willing" reveal his nature. He loves to love! He desires to do great works for others! Likewise, our heart should be like his. We should desire to love others with the same love in which Jesus loves us.

RESPOND: Are you willing to show Jesus' love to others? How are you doing this in your home, work, and school? Ask God to give you opportunities to share his love with others.

Friday

READ: Romans 15:2; Galatians 5:14

REFLECT: Loving our neighbors means that we should be present and available whenever they need us most. In doing so, we can point them to the love of Jesus that is always present. There is no greater way to show someone that God loves them than by loving them as God has loved us.

RESPOND: Think back to a time when someone else shared God's love with you. How did that make you feel? Did it point you to God's love? What was your response?
