Monday

READ: John 13:1-17

REFLECT: Jesus' act of washing his disciples' feet was not just an example for them to follow, it was also one of rebuke. They were waiting to be served instead of proactively looking to serve others. Jesus took on the role of a servant by taking up the basin and the towel (and later the cross) to do a job the disciples weren't willing to do.

RESPOND: What are you willing to do that no one else is? If there is nothing you can think of, why not? Look for opportunities this week to proactively serve like Jesus.

Tuesday

READ: John 13:34-35; Colossians 4:5

REFLECT: The unbelieving world should be attracted to Jesus and his gospel by our love for one another. Loving others is the best way to "act wise" in the presence of unbelievers. When we do, we are positioned to make the best of every opportunity we have.

RESPOND: How have you acted "unwisely" in the presence of unbelievers? What lessons did you learn? Spend time with God and ask him to give you strength and wisdom to act wisely as you serve others and attempt to share your faith with them.

Wednesday

READ: Mark 10:43-45

REFLECT: Greatness is defined by being willing to serve others. Many people today view greatness as being in control and having enough power and money to have others serve them. Yet, Jesus, the most powerful of all, did not see it this way. He revealed that true greatness is being like him.

RESPOND: Who are the people you admire in your career? Do they speak of serving others or do they promote their own interests? How do Jesus' words and example differ from theirs?

Thursday

READ: Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 2:42-46

REFLECT: These two passages reveal what those in the church experience when they use the authority God gives them. It is not an authority to chase after their own desires but one that is to be used to love and serve others.

RESPOND: How do you use the influence and authority God has allowed you to have? Do you use them to serve others or serve yourself? Ask God how you can better serve others.

Friday

READ: Romans 12:3-21

REFLECT: Love is a verb. It is an action that you do, not just a word you say. Romans 12 provides us with several ways we can show love to others. The good news is that God gives us each gifts that we can use to serve others.

RESPOND: If you stopped using the word "love" and instead, just showed love, would others still know that you love them?
