Once again Jesus went out beside the lake. A large crowd came to him, and he began to teach them. As he walked along, he saw Levi son of Alphaeus sitting at the tax collector's booth. "Follow me," Jesus told him, and Levi got up and followed him. While Jesus was having dinner at Levi's house, many tax collectors and sinners were eating with him and his disciples, for there were many who followed him. When the teachers of the law who were Pharisees saw him eating with the sinners and tax collectors, they asked his disciples: "Why does he eat with tax collectors and sinners?" On hearing this, Jesus said to them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners." – *Mark 2:13-17*

Monday

READ: Matthew 9:36; Mark 2:13-17

REFLECT: Jesus saw the crowds and was moved to compassion. He was able to see each unique individual for who they were. One example of this is Levi. As a tax collector, Levi was scorned by his fellow Jews and belonged to a group that was not thought of highly. Because Jesus saw Levi in the midst of the crowd, Levi's life was transformed.

RESPOND: How has your life been transformed because Jesus saw you? How do you see others as unique individuals?

Tuesday

READ: 1 John 4:7-12

REFLECT: Humans did not invent love. God did. In its truest sense, we cannot truly love unless we love as God loves. God showed mankind He loves them by sending Jesus to die on the cross. This act of sacrifice reveals that love is not love without putting others before yourself. We best mirror God's love for us when we love others sacrificially.

RESPOND: How have others shown you sacrificial love? What are some ways you can show sacrificial love to someone this week?

Wednesday

READ: 1 John 4:20-21

REFLECT: We cannot receive love from God while refusing to give it to others. Jesus is saying that doing so is hypocritical. To say, "I love God" is much easier than actually showing love to others. John says that this claim to love God must also be seen. And our love for God is best seen through our love for others.

RESPOND: Praise God for his love through the cross. Ask Him to help you demonstrate this love to others. Write down how you can demonstrate love to someone in your life.

Thursday

READ: Mark 12:30-31

REFLECT: We can obey God without loving Him, but we cannot love Him and not obey Him. God wants us to love others like we love ourselves. To obey this command, we have to accept God's love of us and love Him in return. As one pastor said, "A thousand empty burnt offerings do not mean more to God than a single act of love done in His name."

RESPOND: Ask God to give you the strength to love Him and others. Choose one individual in your life and ask God to show you how to love them.

Friday

READ: Colossians 4:5-6

REFLECT: Being wise toward outsiders includes those who do not follow Jesus. This is a call for intentionality and discernment. Each individual will need to be loved differently in a variety of situations. We cannot love and reach everyone in the same way.

RESPOND: Think of one person in your life. Ask God for help to be intentional and discerning in demonstrating God's love toward them.
