Monday

READ: John 22:15-19

REFLECT: Peter's story is given to us, in part, so that we may see the redemption and restoration God offers to anyone who returns to Him in confession and repentance. While we know this to be true, doubt can creep in and make us think that God won't keep His promises. Peter's story reminds us that there is no one beyond God's forgiveness.

RESPOND: If you ever doubt God's forgiveness, confess your struggle to another believer. If you don't struggle with this kind of doubt, allow God to use you to help others who may be struggling.

Tuesday

READ: 1 John 1:9

REFLECT: This verse assures us that His forgiveness is based on His eternal faithfulness, love, grace, and justice. Our forgiveness is not determined by our feelings but on God's decision. It is not dependent on how often we succeed or fail; it is based on His character.

RESPOND: Ask God to help you trust in His character, not your emotions. Spend time thanking Him for His unchanging goodness, grace, and mercy that is constant every day.

Wednesday

READ: Romans 7:24-25

REFLECT: Paul reveals his heart by expressing his struggle with sin and self-doubt while ultimately pointing to Christ as the answer to both. Doubt looks to self as the solution. Faith looks to Christ as the solution.

RESPOND: Where do you find yourself looking to the most — yourself or Christ? Ask God to help you see the areas of your life where you struggle with doubt. Talk to God about those doubts.

Thursday

READ: John 20:27

REFLECT: Thomas expressed doubt over Jesus' resurrection. He refused to believe unless he saw the evidence for himself. Rather than rebuking his doubt, Jesus responded with compassion. He invited Thomas to draw near. Likewise, God does not condemn us when we doubt. Instead. He invites us to come closer to Him.

RESPOND: Be honest with God and another believer about any doubt you may be experiencing. Ask Him for the strength to be honest with yourself, others, and Him.

Friday

READ: John 8:44; Revelation 12:9

REFLECT: Satan often feeds off our doubt by speaking lies about ourselves and God. He is the supreme liar. This is why God's Word warns us about Him. God does not want doubt to destroy our faith; He wants doubt to build our faith!

RESPOND: What are some ways you can protect yourself against the lies of Satan? Ask God for His protection and wisdom to help you stand firm against Satan's attacks.


