

Monday

READ: 1 Peter 3:15

REFLECT: We often read this verse and think it's only about defending our faith intellectually. But we also prove our faith through the beauty of our lives. When people see this beauty, they will be more likely to ask "the reason for the hope that you have".

RESPOND: How can others see the beauty of the gospel through you? Ask another believer to encourage you by answering this question about you from their perspective.

Tuesday

READ: Genesis 3

REFLECT: Many people today view sin primarily as an action we do that causes harm to others or ourselves. There seems to be little thought of sin as an assault against God. Thus, as long as an act does not cause anyone harm, it is not a sin. This passage teaches us that sin is primarily an act against God before it is an act against anyone else.

RESPOND: How does a biblical view of sin change how you view others? Ask God to reveal your sin against Him. Praise Him for His forgiveness and mercy.

Wednesday

READ: Acts 17:28

REFLECT: When we become God's children, we are "in Christ". This means we are so closely connected to Him that we represent Him to others and glorify Him with everything we do and say. When we live out our identity "in Christ," we will be wise in how we treat and view others in all of our interactions and relationships with them.

RESPOND: Ask God to show you your identity in Christ. Do you need to seek forgiveness? Do you need to forgive yourself? Ask God what next steps He has for you.

Thursday

READ: 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

REFLECT: In Paul's day, the physical body was viewed as separate from anything spiritual, so it didn't really matter what one did to his or her body. The soul was what really mattered. God's Word teaches us that our bodies are temples where the Holy Spirit resides. So, why would we settle for less with a sexual lifestyle that dishonors God?

RESPOND: Rededicate your body (and mind) to God. Thank Him that you are not defined by your past and ask Him for a renewed focus on glorifying Him with your body.

Friday

READ: Matthew 22:30

REFLECT: This verse conflicts with what many Christians have come to desire in life — finding a soulmate and living happily ever after. However, God's Word teaches us that marriage, while wonderful, is ultimately a means to glorify Christ.

RESPOND: If you're married, ask God to bless your marriage so that it brings glory to God. If you're longing for a better marriage or are not married, how can you turn your focus on Jesus, your ultimate satisfaction?

PCC College Summer Gatherings


Community for 18-22 year olds
