	READ: Ephesians 4:15-16
When a Christian is hurtful, it sometimes comes from	<b>REFLECT:</b> In this passage, the church is described as a body with Christ as the head and its members as parts of the body. When the body functions well, all is well. But, when the spiritual body doesn't function well, we can hurt one another. This is not what God desires. He wants His body to function in a healthy way.
a – Matthew 16:16-23	<b>RESPOND</b> : Confess to God the times when you may have hurt other believers. How is God calling you to restore this relationship? Confess to God any hurt you are still holding onto and ask God to do a transformative work in your heart.
a – 1 Corinthians 3:1-3	Tuesday
	READ: Matthew 18:15-16
a – 1 John 2:11	<b>REFLECT:</b> This passage is about conflict between believers. Rather than talking to others, God wants you to talk to the believer with whom you are in conflict. Conflict will always exist without clear and direct communication. Therefore, we must be willing to engage directly with one another with the hope of humble restoration and peace. <b>RESPOND:</b> Ask God for strength and discernment to help you engage with another
a – John 21:17	believer with whom you may be experiencing conflict.

	READ: Romans 14:1-13
When a Christian lets us down, God invites us to	<b>REFLECT:</b> This passage encourages us to love other believers to the point of surrendering our personal freedom in Christ for their benefit. We must guard our hearts from being too focused on self that we are unaware of how our actions impact others. <b>RESPOND:</b> Ask God to show you how your freedom in Christ can cause other believers to stumble. How can you surrender personal freedoms for the benefit of other believers?

1. Relocate Out FSall11 140.3-3	READ: Matthew 7:3
2. Choose instead of	<b>REFLECT:</b> Sometimes we are only focused on the hurt done to us and we ignore how we have hurt others. We must first search our hearts to see if there is any hurt we have done to others. We can then focus on the hurt done to us. While hurt can be challenging to uncover, God wants us to look at ourselves first before pointing out the sins of others. <b>RESPOND:</b> Ask God to reveal any hurt you've caused to others. Confess anything God
– Philippians 2:14; Ephesians 4:2-3, 31-32	brings to your mind. Then ask Him for wisdom on how to handle this hurt you've caused.

	READ: Matthew 6:14
	<b>REFLECT:</b> Our salvation is not based on what we do or don't do. Jesus says that unless our relationships with others are right, our relationship with Him won't be right. While it

RESPOND: Is there someone you need to forgive? Ask God to help you in the forgiveness process. Ask another believer to walk with you in this journey of forgiveness.
