

REOPENING KIDCITY

Service Times

- KidCity will be open at the 9:00 am and 11:00 am services starting August 16, 2020.
- We will not be offering KidCity on Saturday nights at this time.

Check-in

- We will provide one volunteer to check families in at each Express Check-in station.
- The main entrance to KidCity will open 15 minutes before service with two lanes for families to enter.
- Everyone that enters KidCity will be checked for fever with a touch-free thermometer. This includes volunteers, parents and all children.
- Everyone that enters KidCity will be required to sanitize their hands as they enter.
- In accordance with the state mandate, everyone that enters KidCity will be required to wear a mask. This excludes infants, toddlers, pre-schoolers, and children in Kindergarten or 1st grade.
- Each family will be allowed 2 adults to enter KidCity to escort children to classrooms.

Classrooms

- We will not be serving any snacks in KidCity.
- No snacks or toys may be brought into KidCity with your child, with the exception of a bottle for your infant.
- We will eliminate any activity that requires shared supplies (crayons, glue, etc.).
- All toys and surfaces will be cleaned and sanitized at the end of every service before the room can be used again. We will eliminate toys that cannot be easily cleaned.
- Our classroom capacity will be reduced to allow smaller groups. This number will be reflected at the check-in stations and classrooms will close when the full capacity number has been reached.

TinyTown (Infants - 2 yrs.)

- All bottles must be clearly labeled with your child's name.

MidTown (3-5 year olds)

- Children in our MidTown classes will not leave the classroom for their Large Group experience.

UpTown (Kindergarten-4th gr.)

- The Bibles-N-Bucks store will be closed at this time. We will not be handing our Bible Bucks until further notice.
- In UpTown, kids will go to the Large Group experience. We will have each small group sit together, social distancing from the other groups.
