Monday

READ: Genesis 21:8-21

REFLECT: Hagar's despair blinded her. But when God opened her eyes, she saw a well where she was able to retrieve water for her boy. She began to see that God did not leave her and He was nearer than she thought. There are times when you may feel like God has forgotten you. He has not; he is near. And His provision is close by as well.

RESPOND: What in your life is causing you to not experience God's presence and provision? Ask God to reveal this to you and ask Him to reveal His presence to you.

Tuesday

READ: Psalm 18:1-6

REFLECT: David was alone and on the run from Saul. He called out to the Lord in his loneliness and God answered him in unexpected ways. When we cry out to Him, we are not doing so to help Him know where we are. He knows where we are. We cry out for our sake, so that we may know where we are and where God is.

RESPOND: Spend time offering your complaints to God. Let him know how you feel. Make a decision to trust Him just for today. Take it one day at a time.

Wednesday

READ: Deuteronomy 31:6

REFLECT: Moses told the people of Israel that God would never leave them or forsake them. He wanted this reality to give them courage to press on regardless of what obstacles awaited. God will never leave or forsake you. When we lean into this promise, we will discover a strength we could not muster up for ourselves.

RESPOND: Praise God that He does not leave or forsake you. Thank Him for His never-ending presence. Ask Him to fill you with confidence because of this awesome reality.

Thursday

READ: Psalm 25:16; 142:4

REFLECT: God wants us to connect with others. When we are living our life without others, it can cause us to experience feelings of loneliness. God is a good Father who wants us to have deep and meaningful relationships.

RESPOND: Praise God for the friends He has given you. Seek to be a friend to others and to fulfill their God-given longing to connect.

Friday

READ: John 14:16-18

REFLECT: The Holy Spirit is given to us as a promise from God that He does not leave us as orphans. If we're believers, we can both experience Him and receive strength to move beyond our feelings of loneliness to see reality as God sees it. God does not leave you in a vulnerable and helpless state. He is near. He is present with you and in you.

RESPOND: Write down times when you sensed the Holy Spirit in your life. Praise God for those moments and ask Him to make you more aware of His presence in your life.

SPRING BREAK 2025

In early 2021, Pathway was presented with the opportunity to partner with Compassion International to build a church, student center, and community well in the Dodoma region of Tanzania. Thanks to your generous gifts, the facilities were completed in June of 2021. In January of 2022, the people of Pathway sponsored 624 children in this community and surrounding areas. This Compassion church in Tanzania is currently ministering to an impoverished community of people (50% of whom are children) and has become the center of a life-changing experience for 150+ children and their families.
