Monday

READ: Psalm 42:5

REFLECT: Many of us look for hope in all the wrong places. This psalmist rebuked his own soul for its lack of hope. In short, he is saying, "Soul, what in the world? What reason do you have to be hopeless? God is too good for you to feel that way!" The psalmist's hope was directed toward God. He knew only God could satisfy his longings.

RESPOND: Spend time thinking about God's goodness in your life and about the hope it offers. Through this week remember His goodness and the hope it can give you.

Tuesday

READ: Psalm 25:5

REFLECT: It was God's truth that directed how David should live. This guidance gave David hope that, if he followed God, he would never go astray and be lost. David knew he would always experience hope when he followed God's truth and guidance.

RESPOND: Is God guiding you somewhere that you have not followed? Ask God to give you strength to follow His guidance so that you can experience hope in Him.

Wednesday

READ: Isaiah 40:31

REFLECT: In this chapter, God's people were hopeless because they had been exiled from their homeland. Isaiah redirected their attention to God's love and strength in the midst of their heartache. He encouraged them that when they rely on God and trust in Him their hearts will be filled with strength for the present and hope for the future.

RESPOND: What is keeping you from living like Isaiah 40:31 says? Ask God to help you discern why and to fill you with His strength and hope today.

Thursday

READ: Micah 7:7

REFLECT: In this chapter, Micah acknowledges that the misery God's people are experiencing is a natural and spiritual consequence of their sin. Yet, he directs God's people to confess and repent while waiting on the Lord. This waiting was an expectant hope that God would come through. God gave Micah incredible hope for the future.

RESPOND: Spend time writing down how God has been faithful to you in the past. Then write statements of hope that read something like, "I know God will ______."

Friday

READ: Romans 15:13

REFLECT: Toward the end of his letter to the Roman believers, Paul prays that their experience of God's hope would fill them with peace and joy. He acknowledged that this peace, joy, and hope was something they could not muster up on their own strength. They needed the power of the Holy Spirit to give this to them.

RESPOND: Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you with God's hope, peace, and joy. Then look for ways to encourage others with this hope, peace, and joy.
