Monday

READ: Matthew 5:4

REFLECT: In a world that pursues happiness as the ultimate goal, mourning and grief are things we often avoid. However, this is not reality. Only after we recognize sorrow can God comfort us. As citizens of God's kingdom, we will mourn, but we will not mourn without hope.

RESPOND: What are some promises you can cling to as you face the reality of our world? Ask God to help you acknowledge both sorrow and His comfort.

Tuesday

READ: Isaiah 61:1-2

REFLECT: Jesus was sent to provide comfort to humanity. To experience this comfort, we must first acknowledge our sin and suffering. If we don't acknowledge this, then we won't see a need to be comforted and will not reach out to God for His comfort.

RESPOND: Bring your grief to Jesus. Tell Him your hurts and disappointments. Ask Him to comfort you as He has promised.

Wednesday

READ: Lamentations 3:19-24

REFLECT: Jeremiah highlights two things we should remember when going through hard times. First, we need to be aware of the pain surrounding us and within us, rather than avoiding it. Second, we should look above us to God's comfort. The good news is that when we embrace our mourning, we can be embraced by God's comfort.

RESPOND: Spend time with God and be real about what's going on in your life. Ask Him for His comfort and help in whatever is causing you grief.

Thursday

READ: Psalm 34:18; Psalm 50:15

REFLECT: The Lord is close to those who acknowledge their mourning and pursue Him. When we are brokenhearted over our sin, instead of experiencing judgment, we receive God's grace. We encounter divine favor and acceptance, not condemnation and rejection!

RESPOND: Is there anything you need to confess to the Lord? Spend time asking God to reveal anything in your life that may not please Him. Praise Him for His grace!

Friday

READ: 2 Corinthians 1:3-7

REFLECT: God does not want us to keep His comfort to ourselves. He wants to use us to comfort others. He will often place people in our path who are currently experiencing what we have recently endured. God does this because He knows we can make an impact in their lives in ways that others cannot.

RESPOND: Ask God to open your eyes to see the people He has placed in your path. Ask Him to help you comfort them with His comfort.
