Monday

READ: Matthew 5:9; Isaiah 9:6; John 14:27

REFLECT: Jesus is the Prince of Peace. As His children, we are to replicate His peace in the world and in our relationships. As Jesus made peace possible between God and man and among all human beings, we, as God's ambassadors, can strive to initiate and maintain peace wherever we go.

RESPOND: Are you a peacemaker or a peace-destroyer? What are some ways you can initiate and maintain peace in your relationships?

Tuesday

READ: 2 Thessalonians 3:16

REFLECT: God doesn't merely possess peace. He is peace. His presence implies the presence of peace. However, there are times when we forget about His presence and chaos reigns inside of us. Paul's prayer here is that we will experience God's peace at all times and in all ways. This is only possible when we are aware of God's presence. When we are aware of His presence, we can experience His peace.

RESPOND: What are some distractions that cause you to forget about God's presence? Ask God to help you be aware of His presence today and to fill your heart with His peace.

Wednesday

READ: Philippians 4:6-7

REFLECT: In this passage, God wants us to know that peace in our hearts will follow when we pray about our concerns. In short, we can replace anxiety with prayer. God's peace is not possible without prayer!

RESPOND: Write down any of the anxieties you are facing. Spend time praying about them. Give them to God and ask Him to help peace reign in your heart.

Thursday

READ: Isaiah 57:18-19

REFLECT: God calls us to bring peace to the world. While we may not serve as an official peacekeeper, we can bring peace to our world. God has given each of us a specific sphere of influence. We can speak peace into the lives of people in a way that no one else can.

RESPOND: How can you bring peace to those in your sphere of influence? Ask God to show you people who need God's peace today.

Friday

READ: Romans 12:9-21

REFLECT: God wants us to be active pursuers of peace in our relationships, not just passive accepters. In short, He wants us to make the first move in seeking peace with others. We can do this by thinking about our actions through the lens of the gospel and by being selfless, humble, and approachable.

RESPOND: Rather than focusing on how others are making peace difficult, ask God to reveal how you can make peace more possible through your own words and actions.

FINANCIAL FREEDOM IS WITHIN REACH

Financial Peace University is a life-changing program that will provide you with the plan and the tools to achieve your financial goals. In this five-week class you'll learn practical steps to eliminate debt, build savings, and attain financial freedom. If you (and your spouse) attend and complete 5 out of 5 sessions, you will graduate from FPU. If you graduate, we will refund all your expenses from FPU back to you!

Cost: \$25 per person/couple
