Monday

READ: Psalm 10:14; Psalm 68:5; Deuteronomy 10:18

REFLECT: God is the defender of the orphan because they are defenseless and have no inherent benefits that a family would provide. He is their helper. He looks out for them, and his beautiful heart is displayed in his love for them!

RESPOND: In what ways has God defended and looked out for you? Praise him as he reveals these ways to you.

Tuesday

READ: Deuteronomy 14:29; Psalm 82:3; James 1:27

REFLECT: The family of God should have the same attitude and love for orphans that God does. Possessing God’s heart for those who cannot defend themselves is at the very core of what it means to be a child of God. As God defends and helps orphans, we are to do the same. In fact, we can be his hands and feet in doing so!

RESPOND: What is one thing you can do to demonstrate love for those who are orphans? Ask God to reveal this to you and look for those opportunities.

Wednesday

READ: Romans 8:14-17; Ephesians 1:5

REFLECT: If you are a follower of Christ, not only has God forgiven you, he has also made you his child. He has adopted you! As a result, you have been given rights to an inheritance that is literally out of this world and is longer lasting than any other inheritance you can receive. This inheritance includes God’s promises, protection, and help.

RESPOND: Write down aspects of the inheritance you now have as a part of God’s family. Thank God for this inheritance and all the blessings you have as an adopted child of God.

Thursday

READ: Exodus 2:1-10

REFLECT: Moses is one of several stories of adoption in the Bible. By faith, Moses’ mom (Jochebed) saved his life by placing him in a basket in the Nile River. She didn’t realize it but God had already appointed a new family for Moses. God’s providential hand is on those whom he helps. He places them in homes where they are loved and nurtured.

RESPOND: Is God calling you to be one of those homes? If so, what is your next step?

Friday

READ: Esther 2:15-18

REFLECT: Another adoption story is that of Esther’s. Because Esther lost her parents when she was young, her uncle Mordecai adopted her. Mordecai was able to give her a new chance at life and she ended up being a queen! Again, we see God’s providential hand working behind the scenes to love the fatherless and to advance His purposes. Because of this, we can view our lives through eyes of faith knowing that God is our help.

RESPOND: In what areas of your life do you need to have eyes of faith? Spend time with God thanking him for guiding you so far and use this time to renew your trust in him.
