Matthew 7:13-14

BIG IDEA: Jesus doesn't desire for you to narrowly make it through life, but to

trust He knows WHAT IS BEST FOR YOU.

- 1. The Teachings of Jesus are:
 - · Not from this WORLD
 - Not about <u>TRANSACTION</u> but <u>TRANSFORMATION</u>
 - Not <u>COMPLEX</u> but <u>SIMPLE</u>
 - All about his **LOVE** for you and for your **NEIGHBOR**
- 2. Walking the Narrow Way:
 - Is an INVITATION not a RESTRICTION
 - Is HARD but BEAUTIFUL
 - Leads to a <u>FULL</u> and <u>FREE</u> life
 - Aligns our hearts with God's VISION

Monday

READ: Matthew 7:13-14; Matthew 5:3-12

REFLECT: Jesus' Sermon on the Mount invites us into a full life He desires us to live. The world's vision for our lives is wide and overhyped. Jesus' road is narrow, focused, and full of life. This road is not about missing out; it's about stepping into the life Jesus promised.

RESPOND: Ask God to show you which road you are traveling. Look for ways to be intentional in living out the Beatitudes describes in Matthew 5:3-12.

Tuesday

READ: Matthew 5:13-16

REFLECT: In this passage, Jesus' words are a call to be different from the world. Jesus desires us to live in a way that challenges and gives hope to nonbelievers. However, we are not to live in way that draws attention to ourselves. Rather, we are to let our light of good works shine so that nonbelievers will be drawn to and glorify Him.

RESPOND: How can you intentionally be salt and light to nonbelievers around you? Ask God to give you an opportunity to practice this.

Wednesday

READ: Matthew 5:21-26

REFLECT: On the world's broad road, everyone seems to be easily offended and angry. Anger can lead us down a road of self-destruction and self-pity. Anger actually hurts us more than it hurts others. The narrow road of Jesus compels us toward love, compassion, and mercy rather than anger and hate.

RESPOND: Which road have you chosen to travel lately? Anger or love? Ask God to fill your heart with His love so you can respond to others with grace, mercy, and compassion..

Thursday

READ: Matthew 6:1-4

REFLECT: This passage is about motives. We walk the narrow road when we do good works to bring attention to God, not ourselves. When we reflect on why we do what we do, we may be surprised to discover our motives are more self-serving than not. Only God can transform us so that we serve from a selfless heart.

RESPOND: Spend time reflecting on why you do good works for others. Ask God to reveal your motives for doing good to others.

Friday

READ: Matthew 7:24-27

REFLECT: Anyone who hears Jesus' teachings but does not put them into practice is building their life on sand. It is one thing to agree with Jesus but another to surrender to Him by putting His words into practice. Following Jesus is a way of life. If we don't put His words into practice, our lives will lack a foundation of stability.

RESPOND: What are some practical ways you can put Jesus' words into practice? Write them down, and ask a close friend to help keep you accountable.
