15 MINUTE DAILY

Monday

READ: Matthew 6:19-20; 22-24

REFLECT: While all the things around us are temporary, how we treat those things has an eternal impact. What we do in life echoes in eternity. Our legacy of how we use our time, talent, and treasure that God has given us can have eternal consequences.

RESPOND: What are some practical ways you can use your temporary treasure to make an impact for eternity?

Tuesday

READ: Matthew 9:35-38

REFLECT: Jesus invites us to join Him in rescuing people and bringing them into His kingdom. How we live our lives can impact others' decisions on where they will spend eternity. Being intentional workers of the harvest will ensure we are using our lives to transform the eternal destiny of other people.

RESPOND: Think of another Christian who is doing this well. Spend some time with them and seek their advice on how they make an eternal impact in the lives of others.

Wednesday

READ: 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

REFLECT: While our temporary bodies are deteriorating, our souls are becoming newer every day. While all suffering is temporary, our response to it can transform our hearts and impact others. Because of this reality and through God's power, we can focus on the end goal of our suffering instead of the pain of the moment.

RESPOND: Be honest with God about your pain and ask Him to help you see the end goal of your suffering. Look for ways to impact others through your response to suffering.

Thursday

READ: Colossians 3:1-4

REFLECT: When God owns your heart it's impossible for your stuff to own you. Rather than focusing on protecting your stuff, you will look for ways to use those things to make an eternal impact. Rather than your stuff being your "life," Jesus will be your life. Therefore, everything you do will be a natural byproduct of your life in Him.

RESPOND: Write a list of the "stuff" you treasure. How would you treat these things if God truly owns your heart? Ask God how you can impact others using your "stuff."

Friday

READ: Luke 16:1-9

REFLECT: This parable tells of a manager who uses his master's wealth to gain favor with his master's debtors after being caught mismanaging. Though he was dishonest and out of a job, he was commended by his master for his shrewdness. Jesus' point in this parable is that we should use our wealth honestly and shrewdly — not to hoard it, but to bless others.

RESPOND: Write down ways you can use your wealth in a shrewd way to bless others.

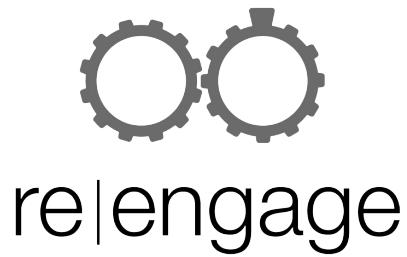
