15 MINUTE DAILY

Monday

READ: Matthew 6:19-24

REFLECT: Jesus says that what we focus on will be what we treasure. We usually fix our focus on what we think will satisfy us. Unfortunately, most of what we focus on is unworthy of our focus. We may realize this and try to split our focus, but we quickly discover that doing so is impossible. We can only focus on one.

RESPOND: What causes you to drift and lose your focus on Jesus? Write down several practical ways you can keep your focus on Him.

Tuesday

READ: Matthew 6:25-34

REFLECT: It is very hard to focus on Jesus and also worry. When we lose focus and forget about His care for us, we think that we are solely responsible for meeting our needs. God does not want us to live like this. He doesn't want us to waste our days worrying and just "surviving." He wants us to focus on Him, be in the moment, and trust Him for the future.

RESPOND: Write down moments where God provided, guided, or sustained you. Even naming doubts can be an act of faith. Reflect on one of these perspectives.

Wednesday

READ: Matthew 7:9-12

REFLECT: Reflecting on who God is will help your perspective. God is a good Father who knows exactly what is best for you. He guides you by His goodness, wisdom, and love. The way you respond to who God is will determine your level of surrender to and trust in Him.

RESPOND: How would your daily choices change if you truly believed God holds your future with wisdom and love?

Thursday

READ: John 6:1-15

REFLECT: This little boy did not have much but he gave it all. If he had only given some of what he had, Jesus may have blessed and multiplied only that. Instead, the boy gave all that he had and got the chance to see Jesus multiply it into something far greater than anyone expected.

RESPOND: Is there anything you are holding back from God? How might releasing control and embracing trust free you to live more generously, bravely, or peacefully?

Friday

READ: 1 John 3:17-18

REFLECT: Giving to others is a way of expressing trust in God that he will replace what we give away. Unfortunately, we often hold too tightly to our wealth because we don't want to lose it. As a result, we are not generous and we hoard our wealth. The antidote to worry and lack of trust in God is to hold our wealth loosely and grow in our generosity.

RESPOND: What is one small step you can take this week to release control of your wealth and be more generous?
